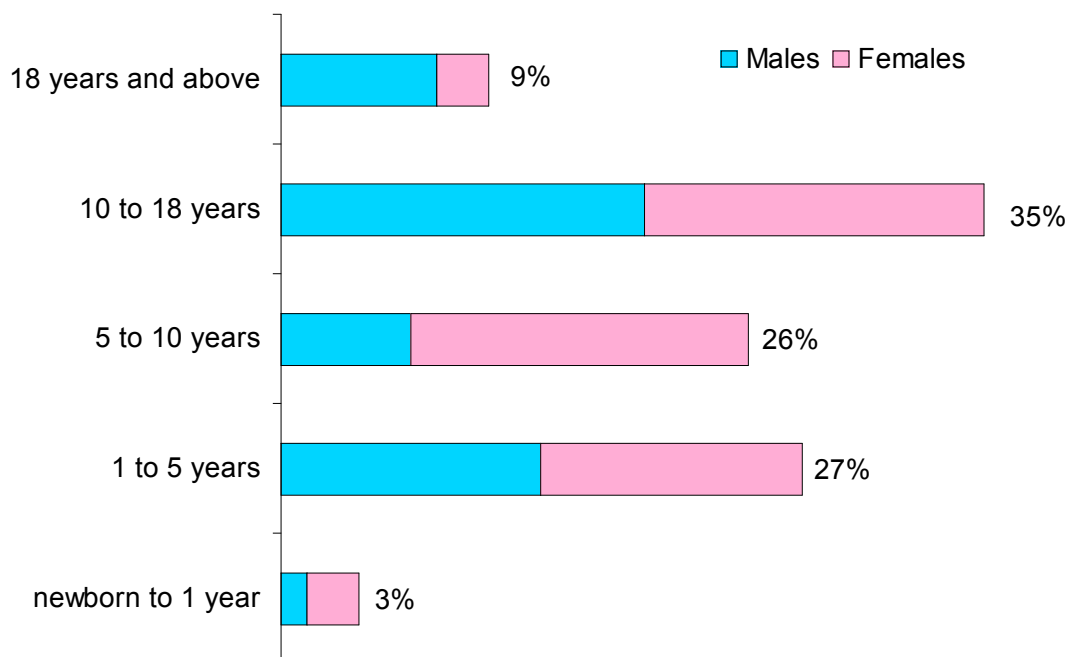


Who are we? Findings from the Corpal Survey

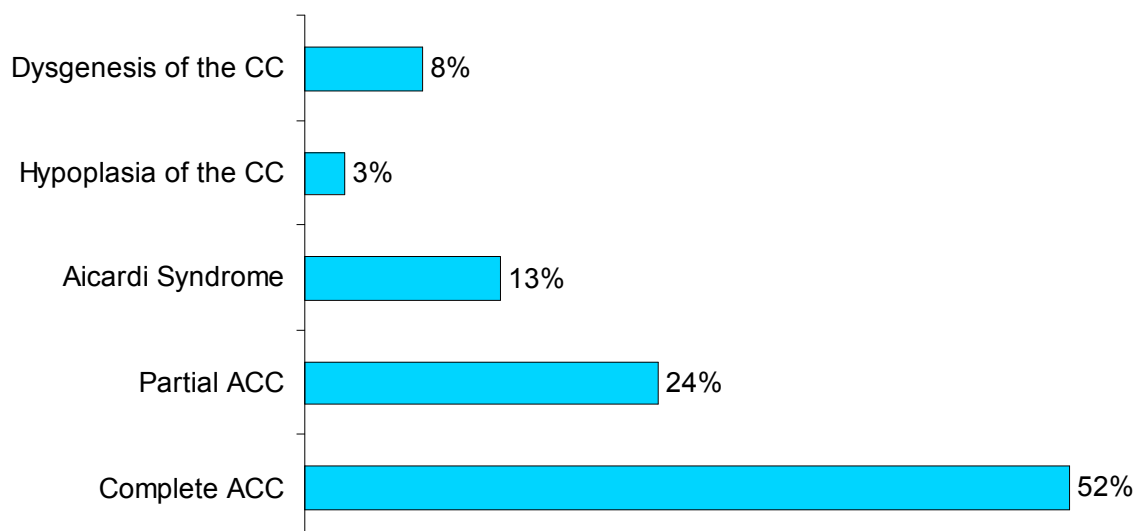
In July 2006 we mailed a survey to 260 registered members of Corpal who had a family member with ACC. Seventy-six (29%) of the surveys were returned. The following provides summary findings (in percentages) of the individuals with ACC. Please note that this survey is a fact-finding exercise and the results have not been used in published research. As is typical in postal surveys the response rate was relatively low and there is no guarantee that those who replied are representative of those who did not. 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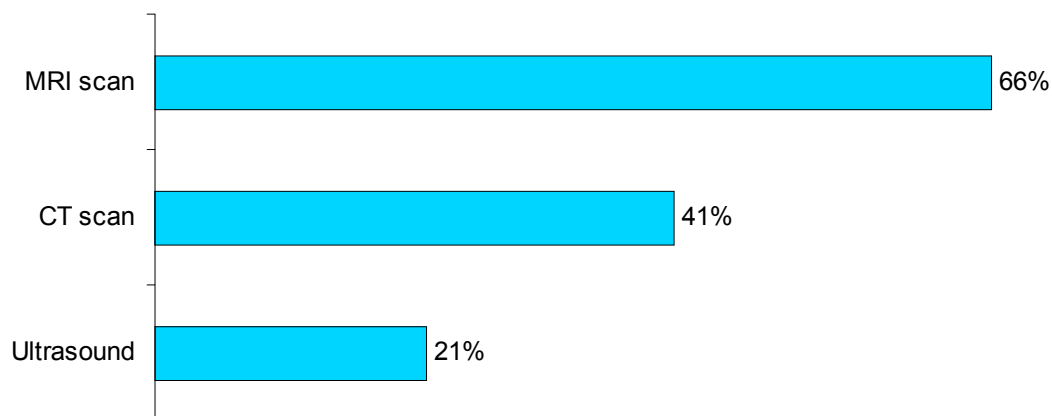
Age and Gender of Individuals with ACC



Diagnosis

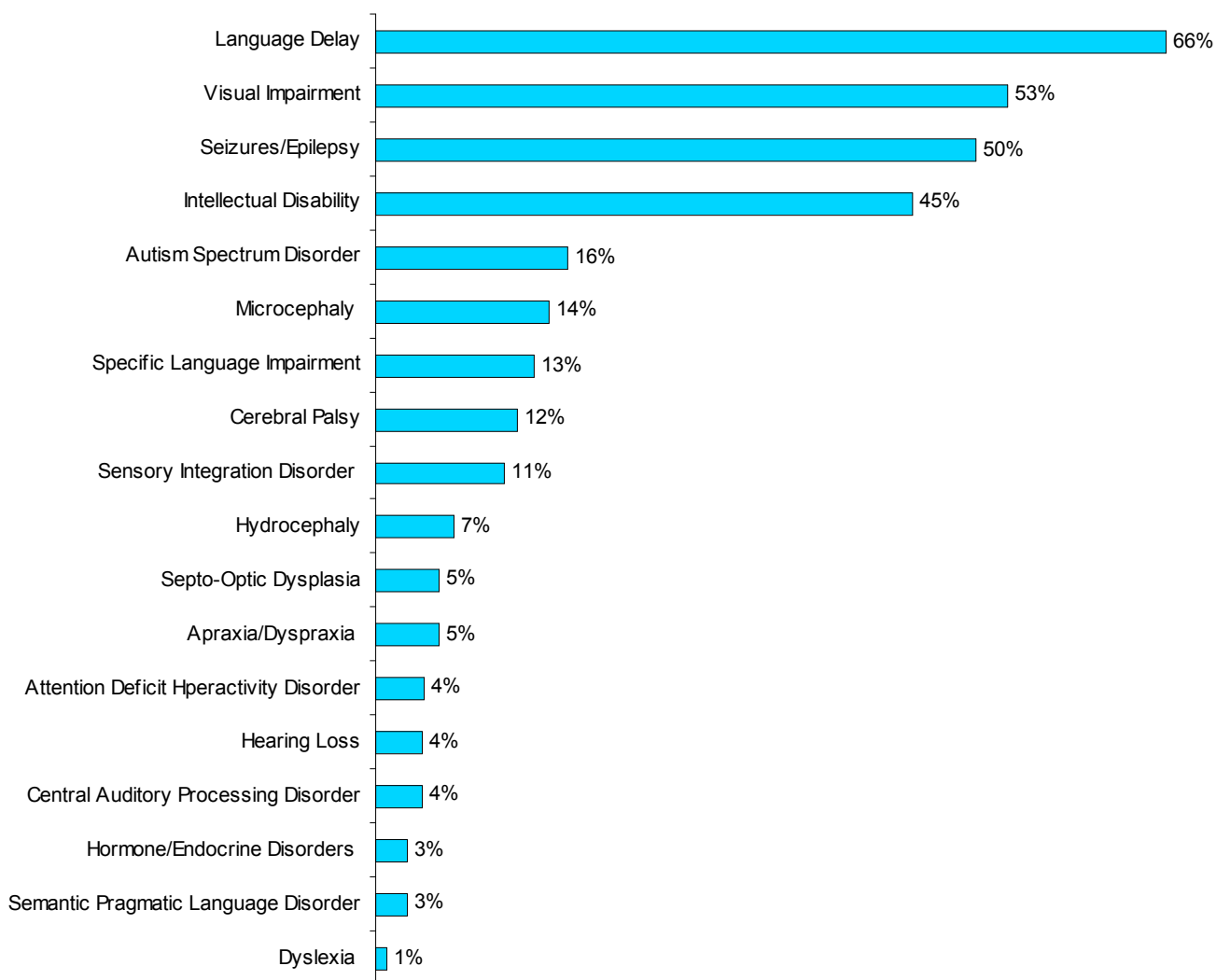


Method of diagnosis

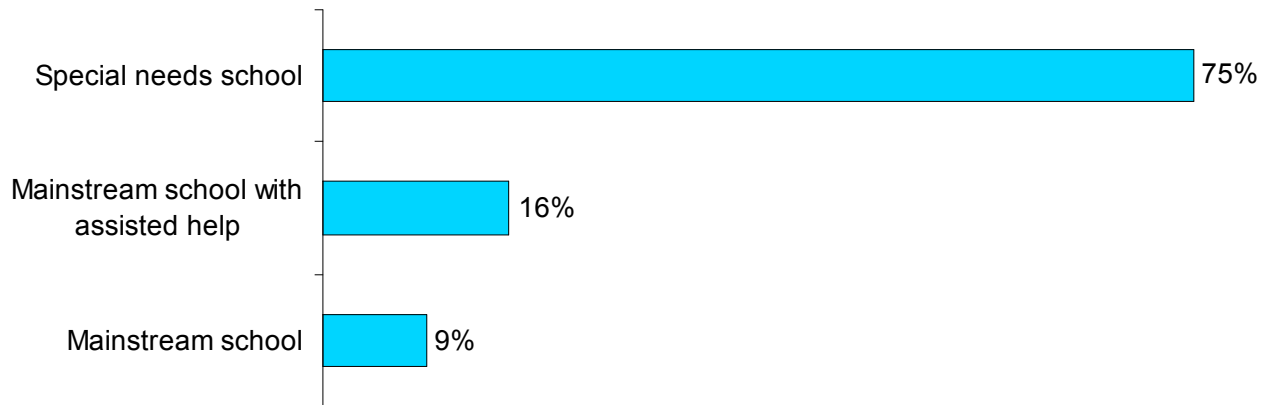


Note: the percentages add up to more than 100% because many individuals had more than one method to determine and then confirm the diagnosis.

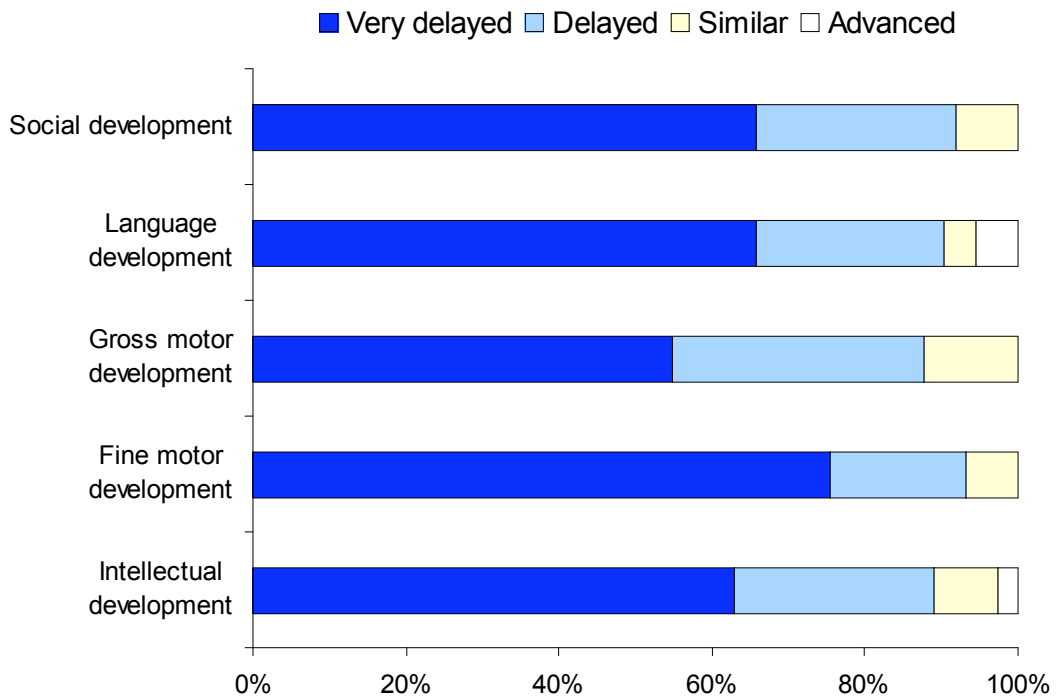
Concurrent conditions



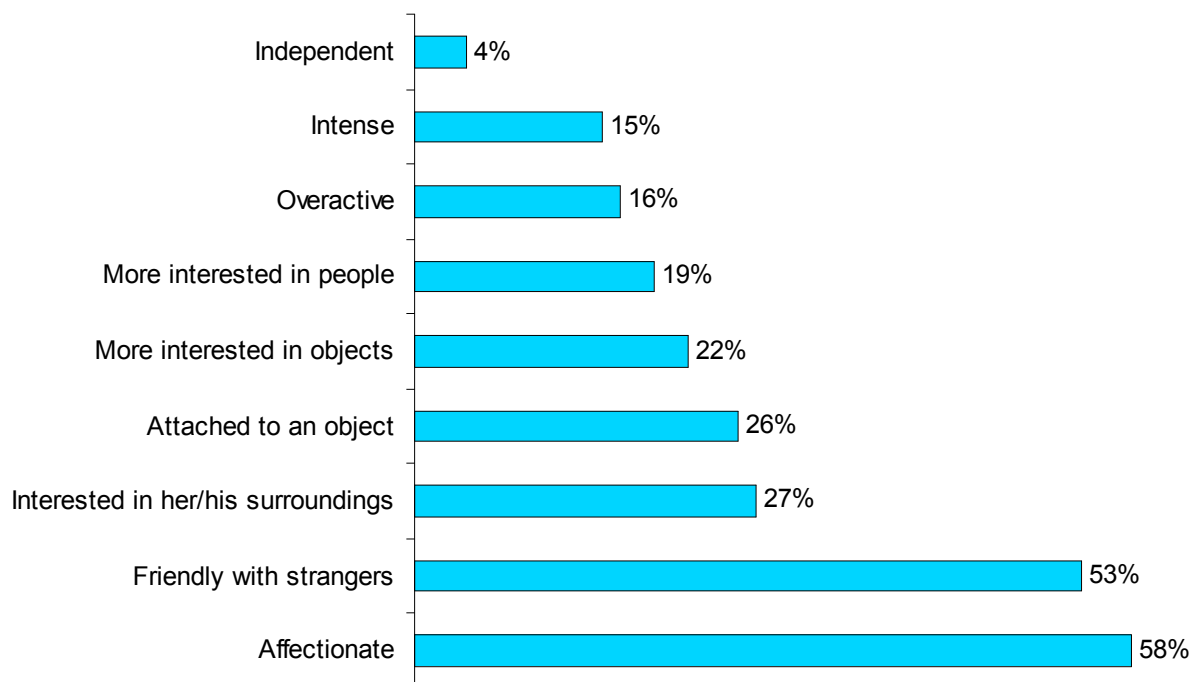
Educational setting for individuals of school age (N = 58)

Parent ratings of infant behaviour



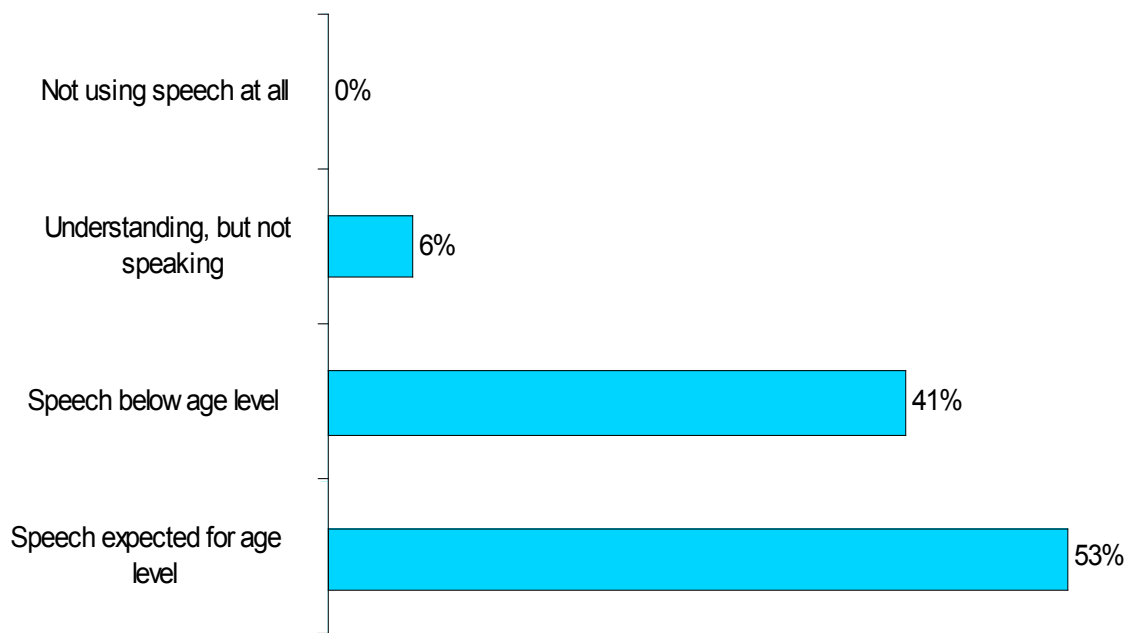
In the following section we separated the sample into those with serious concurrent difficulties (e.g., intellectual disability) and those without. To date, we have data for 54 individuals with serious concurrent difficulties and for 17 individuals without.

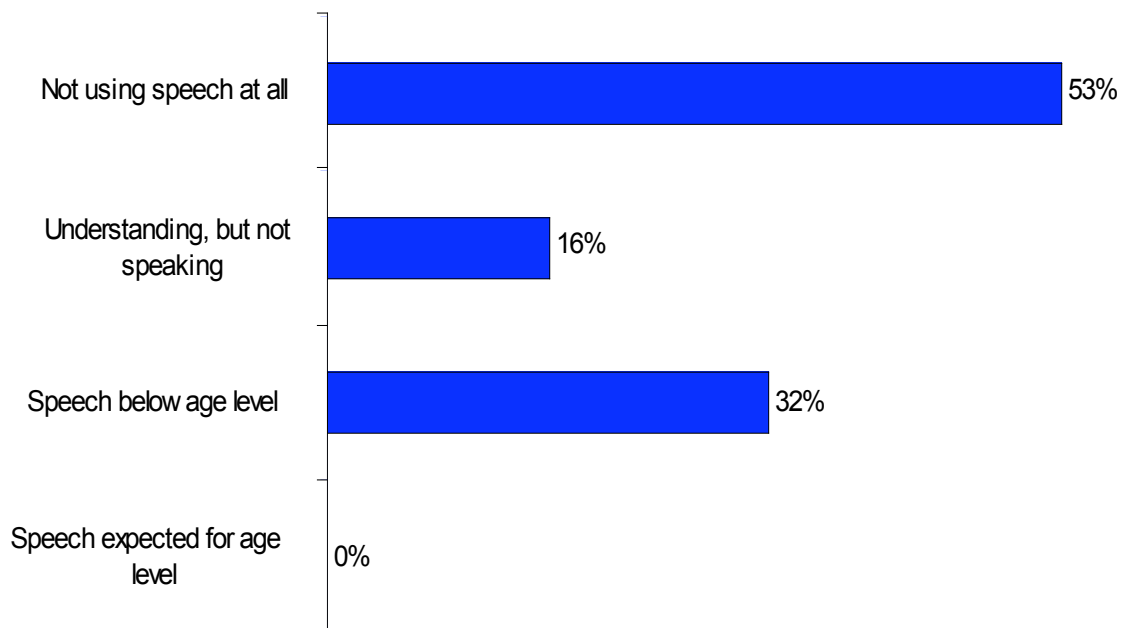

*Note: Where there was a very wide range and some children were far beyond the average, median values are given to provide a more accurate picture.
